WEATHER

At the end of June the weather is usually very fine and hot in Paris.

TRANSPORTATION

It is possible to find **flights** with very good prices for Paris; but it is necessary to book with a sufficient advance. **High Speed Trains (TGV)** link Paris to London, Brussels (Thalys), Germany.

The delegates will transport in Paris and transfer from and to the airports by themselves.

The **metro** and the **buses** are easy and cheap in Paris. The figure of the lines and the name of the stations of the different venues of the Congress are provided.

From and to the airport the **RER** is the more sure and cheap way (45 minutes from Roissy to Gare du Nord and 35 minutes from Orly to Denfert Rochereau)(coast about $11 \in$) or by bus (**Orlybus** from Orly to Denfert Rochereau; trip 25 mn, $7 \in$; **Roissybus** from Roissy to Opera: trip 50 mn, $10 \in$). **Air France buses** are also cheap and useful. **Taxis** can be also used (about $30 \in$ from Orly to Paris; $40 \in$ from Roissy to Paris)

ACOMMODATION

The congress website will provide the names and addresses of hotels with a good level of comfort and price with the web links to help the delegates to book directly their rooms on the hotels website. The situation of the identified hotels will be closed enough to the congress and/or to the metro line 4 which provide the best resources to reach the congress venues.

VISAS

The UE citizens need a valid identity card or passport. Citizens of other countries must check if they need a visa to enter the French Republic territory.

SCIENTIFIC CONTRIBUTIONS

The accepted papers will be presented as key-note lectures, oral communications, posters communications according to the demand of the authors and the final decision of the scientific committee.

The authors will be informed of the decision of the committee and of the schedule of their presentation.

All the oral presentations will be compulsory made using PC Power Point documents. The dimensions of the posters will be: 120 cms (H) x 80 cms (W);
