EADV offers this scholarship to one selected applicant from each Central, Eastern, Western & Northern European country.

MANDATORY CRITERIA

- Must be a Resident/Trainee OR a Specialist in Dermatology and/or Venereology OR a Scientist* in the related field
- Must be under 40 years of age (at the time of the application).
- Must not have previously received one of the above EADV Scholarships
- Must have adequate knowledge of the English language
 *Scientists are required to reach a minimum of 25 points to be eligible, while the other two categories are required a minimum of 5 points

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- The Scholarship Application Form completed online
- A short CV (not more than 3 pages)
- A list of publications written as explained in the document "How to prepare my publications list" available online
- A letter of support, written on official headed paper, signed and stamped, written either by the training director/ head of department, hospital or clinic endorsing the application
- A current copy in English of the applicant's training certificate indicating the start and end date OR of the specialist certificate
- A copy of ID (i.e. identity card, passport) with a passport-size photo

IMPORTANT: Only complete applications filled in according to the requested format will be considered by the Honours and Awards Committee. Applications that are incomplete and/or not filled in properly will be automatically rejected.

SCORING SYSTEM

Evaluation of EADV scholarship applications is made on the basis of an objective assessment of the applicant's scientific activities. Points are awarded according to the following scoring system:

TYPOLOGY OF PUBLICATION	1st or last author (Nr of points)	Any other place in the authors' list (Nr of points)
Paper published in a journal indexed in PubMed	10	5
Book or chapter published by an international publisher	8	4
Paper published in a journal NOT indexed in PubMed	5	2.5
Book or chapter published by a national publisher	4	2
Poster or oral presentation presented in an international congress	1	0
Poster or oral presentation presented in a national congress	0.5	0

To be eligible to apply:

- Trainee or certified specialist in Dermatology and/or Venereology: A minimum of 5 points are required.
- PhD Students or Scientists already holding a PhD degree in Dermatology and/or Venereology and/or Cutaneous Biologyrelated sciences are required to reach a minimum of 25 points.
