EPNS training courses 2010

GENERAL INFORMATION

The EPNS has been organizing training courses in paediatric neurology since 2003 specifically aiming at trainees but also at qualified paediatric neurologists who want to refresh their knowledge on certain topics. The aim is to cover most main topics in the syllabus over a three year cycle and to promote contact between individuals in the speciality in different parts of Europe.

These training courses will be held in the Cheile Gradistei complex, a mountain resort situated in Moeciu, 7km from Bran Castle (Dracula's Castle), 30km from Brasov city and around 170km (3 hours driving) from Otopeni International Airport (Bucharest). These series of courses will be held on a stand-alone basis with two separate courses back-to-back in one week.

You have the option to attend one course or both courses. If you attend both courses you will arrive on Sunday 30 May and depart on Friday 4 June 2010.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

The course programme starts early in the morning and finishes late in the evening, so we strongly recommend that you arrange to travel on the day before the course and depart on the day after the course finishes.

The course cost includes transfers from Bucharest airport to the Cheile Gradistei complex.

There will be 2 buses leaving from Bucharest, Otopeni airport to Cheile Gradistei at 15.30 and 17.30, Sunday, 30 May 2010 and 1 June 2010. Please, book your flight in advance and make sure you reach these two buses! For people attending the first course only, one bus will depart from Cheile Gradistei 2 June 2010 at 08.00 to reach

Bucharest at 11.00. Two more buses will be available from Cheile Gradistei on 4 June 2010 to reach Bucharest at 11.00 and at 15.00. Please book your flights accordingly! If you do not reach these buses, there is a train to Brasov from Gara de Nord, Bucharest Railway station, followed by two buses. Romanian colleagues coming from Bucharest will also be able to take passengers. Details will be provided on request.

ACCOMMODATION

We will book accommodation for you at the Cheile Gradistei complex. Please indicate on the booking form the day you will arrive and the number of nights you will be staying.

We provide one place in a double room (together with another trainee) included in the course fee.

Single accommodation requires supplementary costs (20 euro/night extra = 60 euro for 1 course or 100 euro for both courses)

The fee includes registration at both the Epilepsy and Disorders of motor function courses; accommodation (one place in double room) arriving on Sunday 30 May 2010 and departing Friday 4 June 2010; refreshments during the courses; lunches; evening meals; transfers to/from Bucharest airport (only two buses available!). Accommodation in single room – 100 euro (extra)

BURSARIES

For trainees from income class 1 and 2 countries (see www.epns.info), who are

members of the EPNS, ten bursaries of 500 Euros each are available for each course (20 bursaries available). If a bursary has been awarded by the EPNS, registration is free of charge; for those who have registered for one course, there will be reimbursement of travelling costs to a maximum of 200 euros (presenting travel documents), if travel expenses are less than 200 euro, the exact sum will be reimbursed. For those who have registered for two courses there will be no additional reimbursement. Applicants should send a mail with personal data, curriculum vitae and a recommendation of their local educational supervisor to Mrs. Florentina Grigore at flore.epns@yahoo.com. Deadline for application for bursaries is 1 March 2010. Applications are evaluated by the chairman of the EPNS E&T committe. The applicants will be notified about the decision regarding the awarding of the bursaries within two weeks.
