## Session of the ESEM and the Société de Biomécanique

Thursday December 17, 2009 from 14.00 to 18.00

### OVERALL THEMATIC

The theme of the 2009 joint meeting of the **French Society of Hypertension, ESEM** and the **Société de Biomécanique** is arterial biomechanics in its broadest sense. The meeting addresses researchers active in *in vivo* and *ex vivo* experiments, using mathematical or complex computer simulations, or active in experimental biomechanical labs. Their objective can be improved diagnostics, measurement of arterial function parameters, analysis of the (patho-) physiology, hemodynamics and biomechanics of the arterial and venous system... The meeting equally addresses clinicians active in the cardiovascular field. Clinical studies, case reports, or presentation of new techniques are equally welcome, as long as there is a link with biomechanics.

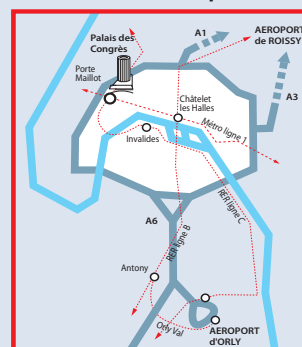

## MANAGEMENT OF CARDIOVASCULAR RISK: FROM THERAPEUTIC INERTIA TO THERAPEUTIC COMBINATION
