

REPORT OF ISMH PRESIDENT, 2010-2012 38th CONGRESS OF ISMH Prof. Dr. M. Zeki Karagülle

37th ISMH Congress was held 23-26 June 2010 in Paris. President of ISMH Prof. Dr. M. Zeki Karagülle (Istanbul) presented the assembly his report about the activities and meetings of ISMH for the 2008-2010 period.
