Medieval Piran, Koper, and Izola are typically Mediterranean at heart and draw visitors with their noble architecture and ancient spirit, while Portorož, the most fashionable seaside resort, bears the trademark of tourism with a tradition of more than 100 years.

PORTOROŽ, the host town of the Congress

Portorož, or the "Port of Roses', began to develop its tradition of hospitality as a climatic health resort and over the decades has acquired many other facilities that offer diversity and quality to the most demanding guests. Superbly appointed hotels - several with thermal pools and private beaches, gourmet restaurants, entertainment in lively cafes, discotheques, and the Casino, along with many sport activities on both sea and land, flights with light aircraft, and strolls along the shore or in the shadow of



subtropical vegetation can fill every day with pleasant experiences. Portorož also has one of the largest and best-equipped marinas on the Adriatic. Especially in summer, the events calendar features a wide variety of cultural performances embracing all artistic fields. The first-class **Bernardin Convention Centre**, a relative newcomer on the stage, is another important player in the conference field and the first real convention hotel in Slovenia. It belongs to the Bernardin hotel complex situated half way between Portorož and the historic town of Piran.
