Dear colleague,

After discussions with all of you during the past months I would now like to invite you to join the scientific board of the ALPE ADRIA CARDIOLOGY meeting 2010 (September 16-18) in Vienna.

- 8) Finally I would ask you to <u>indicate your own specialty</u> you would prefer to be involved in. <u>Please give also names and contact</u> <u>addresses as well as main topics of researchers</u> of your choice in your country. But do not invite them in advance! The organizing committee will do this after we have selected all proposals.
