 - to grow the Register
 - to support the Profession Committee in its strategy to achieve recognition of Specialists in Laboratory Medicine

From our perspective a key priority for this group will be to grow the Register of specialists as a standard bearer of high quality practice hence we will welcome nominations for individuals who share ambitions to promote the Register and increase the number of registrants.

The term of office will be for 2 years ending on 31 December 2018. Procedure for applications

Applicants who are not selected as full members may be eligible for corresponding membership. The candidate has to be \leq 35 years.
