During the first ERA-EDTA Congress in Amsterdam in 1964, it was decided to start a registry including all European patients on renal replacement therapy (RRT) for end-stage renal disease. The first registry Chairman was the famous Dutch nephrologist Willem Drukker and already one year later, during the second EDTA congress in Newcastle, the first Registry Report was presented.


