During the ERA-EDTA General Assembly that was held in Amsterdam last June 2, the composition of the ERA-EDTA Council officially changed. Prof. Andrzej Wiecek (former Secretary Treasurer) took over the presidency of the Association. Prof. Jonathan Gabriel Fox (former Ordinary Council member) became ERA-EDTA Secretary Treasurer. Prof. Christoph Wanner, ERA-EDTA Registry Chair, will end his second term as an ERA-EDTA ex-officio officer in 2015. In the meantime he will participate in the Council meetings with voice but with no vote as the ERA-EDTA Registry Chair Elect.
