

### **Abstract Submission**

Authors interested for **Free Communications or Poster Presentations** are invited to submit, by the deadline indicated below, their abstract which should include: (a) introduction, (b) methods, (c) results, (d) conclusion. The abstract texts for **Case Reports** should be structured: (a) introduction, (b) clinical description, (c) discussion, (d) conclusion. The texts should not exceed 500 words. Abstracts should be submitted through the Congress website (www.psych-relatedsciences.org), according to the guidelines given therein. The official language of the Congress is English. Accepted abstracts will be included in the Congress Abstract Book, provided there is at least one registration per abstract.
