Treatment and prevention of Physical Illnesses in Mentally Disordered

26.08.2013-27.08.2013

Content:

The course deals with physical illnesses in mentally disordered, identification, diagnoses, treatment and prevention. Pharmacological side effects and problems connected to polypharmacy will also be included. Peter Manu, M.D., is Professor of Medicine and Psychiatry at Hofstra University, New York and author of 'Handbook of Medicine in Psychiatry'. Peter Manu is course leader as well as responsible for the teaching. Peter Manu is widely known and respected not least for his benchmarking book.

Scientific Writing and Publishing

26.08.2013-30.08.2013

Content:

The course's aims are to give the young researcher practical training in how to write and publish a scientific manuscript. The senior researcher interested in supervising young trainees in scientific writing is also welcomed.

Povl Munk-Jørgensen (Professor of Psychiatry, Aarhus Universitetshospital, DrMedSc, editor-in-chief Acta Psychiatrica Scandinavica) is course leader as well as responsible for the teaching. The teaching will also be led by Christian Gold (professor, PhD, editor of the Nordic Journal of Music Therapy) and Gregers Wegener (DrMedSc, editor-in-chief Acta Neuropsychiatrica) and Donald Smith (DrMedSc, research psychologist)

Form:

The course consists of teaching as well as interactive workshops. The workshops are based on draft manuscripts submitted by the participants. There will be classes on teaching in scientific English, writing the manuscript, the review process, response to reviewers/revising the manuscript etc. During the workshops the participants will work with their own draft manuscripts, supervised by the three editors.

Delirium

28.08.2013

Content:

The course deals with the assessment and management of patients with delirium and related disorders. Delirium is a heterogenous condition – the course will address many of the commonly encountered pitfalls in everyday management. In recent years there has been increasing research in the sequelae of delirium and how the patients experience delirium. The course will also cover these topics.

Professor of Psychiatry at University of Limerick School of Medicine, David Meagher is course leader as well as responsible for the teaching in collaboration with Chief Consultant Lisbeth Uhrskov Sørensen, Risskov Universitetshospital.

The Research interests of David Meagher include the neuropsychiatry of delirium across clinical settings with particular emphasis on palliative care, consultation-liaison psychiatry and elderly medical populations, including research activity focusing on definition and nosology, improving detection and assessment, clinical (motor activity) subtyping, management and prognostic indicators. Recent work has focused upon the use of computerized technology / electronics in the detection and monitoring of patients with acute cognitive failure/delirium.
