- Receive the personal feedback of the Presidents and Chairmen of the congress who will provide useful advices for the development of the winners' career as researchers and international congress speakers;
- Be hosted by the congress that will waive registration fee and take care of travel and accommodation costs.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR CANDIDATURE:

In order to participate in the selection process, please present before **20 October 2016** the following documents:

- Full academic curriculum including publications and / or poster presentations made in the past
- Complete abstract of the original work you would like to present during the congress.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Compulsory criteria:

- ✓ Abstracts should be related to the topics of the congress.
- ✓ The candidate should be the first author of the abstract.
- ✓ The abstract should be original
- ✓ The abstract should be presented in English
- ✓ The candidate should not have been included in the faculty of a previous international congress

The main selecting criteria will be the relevancy and scientific value of the abstract presented, evaluated by the chairmen of the congress. The choice will be made at the Chairmen's discretion. In case of equality the following priority criteria will be applied.

Priority criteria

- ✓ Age: Priority to researchers / clinicians under 42;
- ✓ Provenience: priority to researchers / clinicians working in low—income countries with limited access to funds.

All the candidates will receive written communication about the outcome of submitted papers around **8** November 2016.

Not selected abstracts for the "Rising star" session could be eligible for poster presentation and may compete for the poster prize. See the instructions in the next page.

In order to participate in the selection process, please present before **3 November 2016** the following documents:

Notification on acceptance of the abstract(s) will be e-mailed to the presenting author by **11 November 2016** and **authors must register for the congress and pay the registration fee before 16 November 2016** to benefit from the early bird registration fee. Otherwise authors need to register by **07 January 2017** in order to confirm their poster presentation. Failure to do this could result in losing the possibility to present the poster during the congress.









GENERAL RULES TO SUBMIT AN ABSTRACT

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- Abstracts should be written in English and the complete abstract must not exceed the box space (320 words). Abstracts could contain formulas, pictures or graph.
- For each abstract a presenting author should be identified.
- All the communications concerning the abstract will be sent to the submitter who will be responsible for informing the other authors of the status of the abstract.
- Submitting an abstract you should select the appropriate category ("Rising Star" or "Poster")
- Submitting an abstract you should select the appropriate topic among the ones identified for the congress.
- Structured abstracts are mandatory stating clearly the Background/Aims, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- We recommend that you prepare your text in a word processing programme (e.g. Microsoft Word) and then copy-paste the final text into the online abstract submission form.
- Abstracts must be submitted on or before the closing date (20 October for rising star, 3 November 2016) for Poster). The organizers reserve the right to reject any abstract for failure to comply with submission instructions mentioned on the congress website.
- It is possible to submit more than one abstract. However, only one presenting author per abstract is permitted.
- Please ensure that your abstract does not contain spelling, grammatical or scientific errors. No corrections are possible after the submission deadline. The abstract will be reproduced exactly as submitted. No proofreading will be done.
- The presenting author must accept full responsibility for the content, submission and presentation of the abstract, and retain full copyright of their abstract and presentation. By submitting an abstract, authors give consent and authorize the organizers to publish or submit for publication their abstract, presentation, picture and biography, and to include them in any congress printed or electronic publications.
- Submitters can go back and make changes to an abstract submitted when it is as a draft copy until the deadline. However, please note that finalized abstracts cannot be edited after approving the drafts.
- Conflict of Interest/Disclosure: Abstracts submitted for presentation must include an acknowledgement of any commercial funding sources. Authors should declare all commercial interests.
- All studies must have been approved by institutional committees on ethics of experimental and human investigations.

GETTING THERE

AIRPORT

There is the Budapest Liszt Ferenc International Airport. Originally called Budapest Ferihegy International Airport (Budapest Ferihegy Nemzetközi Repülőtér), on 25 March 2011 it was officially renamed Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport, in honor of the Hungarian pianist and composer Franz Liszt.

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Budapest International Airport is 22 Km from the city centre.

TRANSFER FROM / TO THE AIRPORT

By taxi:

The fastest and most direct way of getting from Budapest Airport to downtown is definitely by taxi: Telephone: +36 1 222 2 222. Taxi fare for a transfer from the Airport to the city centre costs around 7.000 - 9.000 (23 – 30 Euro) depending on drop off point and traffic.

Private Transfer (only for Budapest Marriott Hotel guests):

You can book your transfer from the Airport to the hotel by calling the concierge on the +36 1 235 4813. Direct phone number to Taxi service by the Hotel: +36 20 975 7681.

Public bus transfers:

The shuttle service (from 7 euros / person) is one of the most popular ways to travel from Budapest Airport to anywhere in Hungary's capital. From 4:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., bus number 200E commutes between Terminal 2 and the Kőbánya-Kispest metro terminal (metro line M3), via the Ferihegy train station (trains to the Nyugati railway station in Budapest).

TRAVELLING BY TRAIN

There are 3 main international railway stations in Budapest: Eastern (Keleti), Western (Nyugati) and Southern (Déli). CLIMATE

Budapest has a humid continental climate with warm summers and no dry season. Daily low temperatures are around -4°C, falling below -11°C or exceeding 2°C only one day in ten. Light snow is quite common in January.

ELECTRICITY

Electricity in Budapest is the European standard 220 Volt with the two round prongs

CURRENCY

The Hungarian Forint is the currency of Hungary. The currency code for Forint is HUF, and the currency symbol is Ft.

Average exchange rates is:

1 Euro = 312 HUF

1 HUF = 0.0032 Euro

but please check you preferred currency exchange website for updated data.

Hotels, taxis and many shops in Budapest usually accept Euros but they may apply a less favorable exchange rate.
