

## **Abridged 73rd World Health Assembly** took place on 18-19 May in Geneva, focusing on COVID-19 Pandemic



The WHA is the main decision body of the WHO and gathers all health ministers from its member states. It took place with dramatic shorted agenda and in a virtual environment, in the context of the COVID-19 pandemics.

The Resolution on COVID-19 response and future emergency preparedness was adopted. It was led by the European Union and co-sponsored by 140 member states. Several health ministers and heads of states highlighted the importance of greater attention to NCD prevention and management, COVID-19 risks causing a major NCD crisis across the world and amplifying the underlying shortcomings of health systems to respond to the health-care needs of people living with NCDs which include many endocrine conditions.
